Dear Parents/Guardians.

The IHSAA and IGHSAU recently updated their pre-participation examination (sport physical) procedures for participants in school activities to be most current in best practices of screening and identifying health concerns of student athletes. We will begin to phase in the new process for all physicals completed after June 1st, 2023. Current physical forms on file will still be honored as evidence of medical eligibility to participate.

A physical exam provided by licensed health care provider (MD, DO, PA, ARNP and in limited score under Iowa law select chiropractors) is still required to participate in athletics and other identified sanctioned activities.

- 1. Bring all four pages of the new "Iowa Athletic Pre-Participation Physical Examination" form to the child's scheduled physical with a provider. The parent/guardian is responsible for filling out pages 1-2 and signing on the bottom of page 2 and top of page 4 PRIOR to the medical exam.
- 2. **Only page 4** is required by the school's athletic department. It must be signed by the health care provider and parent/guardian and uploaded into the individual school's electronic athletics/activities system (Bound) or turned in for participation eligibility.
- 3. Parents may retain a copy of all four pages for their own record. A copy of the completed physical can be shared with the school nurse to go into the student's health file if you wish.
