The school year started on a positive note, and we are now looking forward to school improvement efforts.

The first School Improvement Advisory Committee (SIAC) meeting of the year will be held on Wednesday, September 15 from 5:30-7:00. The board appointed committee fulfills requirements of Iowa Code Section 280.12(2) and makes annual recommendations based on analysis of needs assessment data in the following areas:

- Major educational needs
- Student learning goals (and outcomes)
- Curriculum, assessment, and instruction
- Long-range and annual goals, including and not limited to, state indicators addressing reading, math, and science achievement
- Bullying and harassment prevention, goals, programs, training, and other initiatives

Aligned with SIAC work, on September 8, 2021, the CCSD School Board will hold a work session to consider creation of more authentic, work-based learning experiences and utilization of district facilities. The 1180 building on S. 16th has been an adventure, as the district has needed to pivot a few times. Although there have been interested collaborative partners for use of the parking lot and use of the actual building, both have taken another direction. The CCSD was close to hosting Pella Corporation, as they were looking to move a division of their operation to Clarinda for two years. Pella Corporation has been growing, and the collaboration would have brought light manufacturing and jobs, as well as opportunities for student learning. As business goes, a better opportunity in their own backyard came to fruition.
